

Cruise EGYPT's Historic Nile with TONY STOCKWELL

November 8-15 2010

Egypt is a land of great contrast where ancient and modern life exist side by side. It's mystical appeal has been attracting the imagination and souls of travellers from far and wide for many centuries. A trip along the Nile has always been a must for Tony so he is delighted to be able to invite a select group to join him on a fully escorted 7 night trip and an opportunity of a lifetime to peer into Egypt's rich and colourful past, explore the spiritual history and experience what the history books may not tell us.

NILE CRUISE ITINERARY

Daily workshops with Tony will include tuition on sensing residual energies of ancient landmarks, healing, mediumship, psychometry, psychic work, meditation.

Additional to the workshops, the following excursions are included in the price. This itinerary is subject to change due to lock closures, low water levels but is unlikely to be vastly different

Day 1: Monday 8th November 2010. UK - Luxor.

Depart from Gatwick or Manchester Airport. On arrival, transfer by coach (approx. 30 minutes) and embark.

Day 2: Tuesday 9th November 2010 . Luxor.

Explore The world's greatest open-air museum, the archeological sites of the Temples of Karnak and Luxor Temple.

Day 3: Wednesday 10th November 2010. Luxor – Edfu

Cross to the West Bank to visit the Valley of the Kings, the Valley of the Queens and the imposing Colossi of Memnon.

In the afternoon, sail to Edfu, passing through the Esna Lock en route. Overnight at Edfu.

Day 4: Thursday 11th November 2010 Edfu- Kom Ombo – Aswan

Visit the extraordinary Temple of Horus.

Day 5: Friday 12th November 2010. Aswan.

A morning visit to the High Dam, the unfinished Obelisk and the Philae Temple.

Optional excursion by felucca to visit the Botanical Garden and Mango Island (EG£130, approx. £13 per person).

Day 6: Saturday 13th November 2010. Aswan - Esna.

Optional sightseeing excursion by road or air to the temple of Ramses II at Abu Simbel (EG£790, approx. £79 per person by road/duration approx. 9 hours; EG£1450, approx. £145 per person by air/duration approx. 5 hours). Approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes is spent at Abu Simbel. In the

afternoon, you can view the Aga Khan's Mausoleum and Botanical Garden whilst enjoying your trip on the Nile by felucca, a traditional Egyptian sailing boat before sailing to Esna for an overnight stay.

Day 7: Sunday 14th November 2010. Esna - Luxor.

Optional full day excursion by air to Cairo and visit to the Pyramids, the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities and the bustling Khan-el-Khalili bazaar, with lunch included (EG£2100, approx. £210 per person. Optional half day excursion by road to visit the Temple of Hathor at Dendera (EG£330, approx. £33 per person). These two optional excursions depart early morning from Esna and return to Luxor.

Day 8: Monday 15th November 2010. Luxor - UK.

Optional hot air balloon flight over the West Bank (EG£850, approx. £85 per person, approx. 45 minutes in the air). Optional Camel ride and visit to an Egyptian village.

After lunch on board, transfer by coach to the airport for the return flight to Gatwick or Manchester.

Evening entertainment will include a Sound and Light show at Karnak Temple, a Nubian folklore evening, a fun Egyptian themed party and the opportunity to see Tony at his best and his worst!

- Small but friendly boat.
- All cabins are air conditioned
- All transfers from airport to ship will be by comfortable air conditioned coach.
- On arrival into Luxor, passengers will be required to purchase an Egyptian visa at a cost of £15.00 (sterling) (correct at time of writing).
- Passengers must have 6 months minimum validity left on their passport on their return to the UK and must be British or Irish passport holders
- Flights are with Monarch charter airline.
- Full board basis
- Excursions are optional and are purchased on board the cruise boat.
- Tipping. Traditional but not compulsory. £4 per guest per night includes coach drivers, bell boys, housekeeping bar and restaurant staff.
- US Dollars and Sterling are widely accepted

Cabins

All standard cabins have twin or double beds, a private shower and wc, hairdryer, air-conditioning, an internal telephone, fridge, television and a large window. Smoking is not permitted in any of the cabins. Single cabins (202 & 111), which do not incur a single supplement, have a single bed and the same facilities as the standard cabins. There will be no need to worry if you are a lone traveller as there are many group excursions and group events. There

are a number of single cabins available but we are also happy to arrange same sex sharing in one of the comfortable twin rooms.

Suites

There are two suites on the Top Deck which each benefit from a double bed and a large seating area with a table and two chairs. There is also one 'Junior' suite on the Upper Deck which has a double bed and a small terrace with a table and two chairs. All suites have complimentary tea and coffee making facilities, a safe (free) and bath robes are also provided.

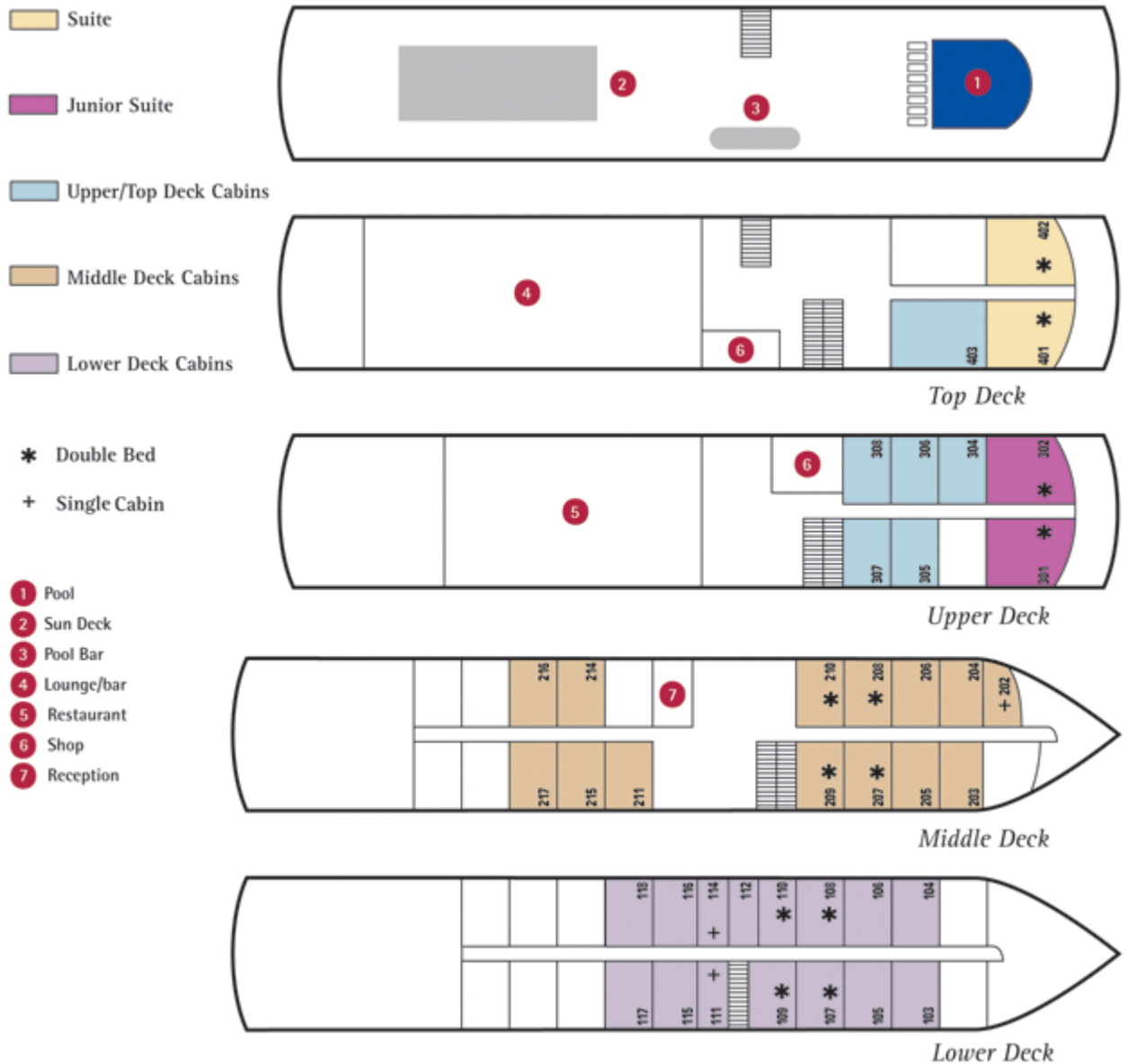
